#### A TAFS is a:


Treasury
Appropriation
Fund
Symbol

It's the primary key for every federal spending account.

It links an appropriations account across data sources and across fiscal years.

#### **Account Code**

1301 = FAA Operations
(air traffic controllers, airspace
ops)

#### Other DOT examples:

1308 = FAA Facilities & Equipment

1129 = Transit Formula Grants

8083 = Federal-Aid Highways



#### Period of Availability

Other common durations: Single-year = 2026/2026 or /26

No-year = X
(available until spent)
